
Appendix 1: Illustration of the prevalence of poverty – the vicious cycle of illiteracy



The high illiteracy levels entail a small, educated population, leading to a small work force, which leads to reduced revenue collected through taxation. This in effect leads to the inability of government to sponsor literacy programmes.


